6. Eligibility and entry

The regatta is open to all Finn sailors born in 1977 or before. Competitors shall submit at the Race Office (Port Jachtowy Świnoujście ul.Jachtowa 1) the following documents:

- i. A valid Finn Class Measurement Certificate
- ii. A passport or equivalent as evidence of the sailor's age.
- iii. valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of € 1,500,000

#### 8. Sailing instruction

The Sailing Instruction will be available at Registration in the Race Office after closing of registration procedure.

9. Measurements

Any boat, portable equipment or the personal equipment of any competitor taking part in the event may be inspected and/or measured and/or weighed by the equipment inspection team at any time.

#### 10. Scoring

Three (3) races shall be completed to constitute a regatta. The Low Point Scoring system will apply. The worst score will be excluded if 4 or more races are completed

11. Environment protection

Competitors throwing wastes into water can be punished by race committee or protest team.

12. Supporting boats

All supporting boats shall be registered during entry procedure

### 13. Media rights

Competitors entering the regatta accept that they may be photographed and/or videotaped by regatta organizers and sponsors and they consent to the taking of such images and to the use, reuse, publication and republication of such images in any media,





without compensation. Each competitor is obliged to attach to the registered boat organizer's and sponsor's advertisements.

### 14. Disclaimer of liability

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death.

15. Other

Recommended wind speed is 5 to 20 knots however final decision is made by the race committee.
